The **NSS VOLUNTEERS** of **CCET** completed the survey regarding the **awareness of Dengue Malaria at Manimajra**in collaboration with the staff members of **CivilHospital**, **Manimajra**.

Household visits were done and all the stagnant water sources were checked. All the coolers and water tanks which were infected with mosquito larva were identified and was cleaned on the spot with the help of the house owners. All the containers, containing water were inspected and cleaned if mosquito larva was found in it. NSS unit of CCET visited more than **350 houses** on Day1.

My team visited **71 Houses** and the members of houses were informed about the risks relates to these standing water and the mosquito larva. My team found 4 POSITIVE LARVA results.
