

STUDENT COUNCIL related FAQs

1. What is SC?

A Student Council is a representative structure for students made by college administration, through which they can become involved in the affairs of the college, working in partnership with the college management and faculty for the benefit of the college and its students.

2. What role does SC plays in the life of a CCET student?

Student Council not only addresses the immediate needs of students, it also helps participating students to offer solutions for long lingering problems of administration and student conflicts.

A Student Council is the primary learning ground before the initial steps in society.
